 Parks usage July thru October 2017
- Five-minute, 20-question survey of 1,200 randomly-selected Parks users at different days/times throughout study period
- Continues and formalizes earlier, unscientific efforts at quantifying Parks use



NYC Police Memorial – New Electrical Vault Construction


- Project scheduled for completion over the next month

Pile Remediation & Caisson Repair


- Ongoing through October 31, 2017
- Preventive maintenance entails strengthening the pilings and caissons that support BPC's Esplanade and landfill – processes that will add decades to their useful life.
- Citywide construction hours:
 - ✓ Monday-Friday, 7am-6pm





South Battery Park City Resiliency (Wagner Park)

- Detailed Design and Engineering RFP issued July 14,
 2017; responses due September 29, 2017
- Project scope includes additional community interface and opportunities for project feedback
- Detailed design and engineering services related to construction of a comprehensive flood barrier system extending from the Museum of Jewish Heritage to corner of Battery Place and State Street
- RFP development follows more than year of feedback/input from wide range of neighborhood stakeholders, elected officials, and in close consultation with State & City partners





West Thames Street Pedestrian Bridge

- Project scheduled for completion by mid-2018
- Joint initiative with NYC Economic Development Corporation, Lower Manhattan Development Corporation, City & State DOT





- ➤ Pier A Ticket Sellers displaced also more aggressive
- > Relocating legal vendors
- ➤ Enforcing No Pet policy on BPC Ball Fields and in West Thames Park
- ➤ Rector Street Lift intercom system checked with Command Center
- > Enforcing NO Drones flying in the park
- ➤ Live Safe / Brookfield emergency alert notification system
- ➤ Monitoring Ball Fields, Teardrop Park, and 75 Battery Place cameras
