This addendum hereby makes the following revisions to Section VII.B of the RFP: The Umbrella Liability Insurance limit requirement is decreased from \$10,000,000 to \$5,000,000. The Data Breach and Privacy/Cyber Liability Insurance limit requirement is decreased from \$10,000,000 to \$5,000,000.

6. Is it the Authority's preference that proposers identify the entire team, including MWBEs and SDVOBs, in the RFP response, or would BPCA prefer to work with the selected proposer to identify the MWBEs and SDVOBs that best meet its objectives?
