
Wayfinding Signage Program: Fabrication and Installation Services RFP

Pre-Proposal Meeting March 10, 2020



Project Background and Description

- In 1993, BPCA instituted a comprehensive wayfinding and signage program that has been updated and modified throughout the years.
- As a result of changes that have occurred within and adjacent to BPC over the past 27 years, the 1993 signage program is outdated.
- BPCA contracted 212/Harakawa, Inc. to design a new wayfinding signage program, which intends to provide improved directional signage for multiple users throughout the public realm and transition points within BPC.
- The signage design was completed in February 2020.
 The services required in this RFP involve fabrication
 and installation of the new signage at specified
 locations throughout BPC.



Project Phases

Phase 1

Fabrication of all signs and the installation of signs that are not in conflict with planned construction and can be installed without need of pending or unresolved City or State agency approvals.

- Fabrication of all 212 signs, including Attic Stock
- Installation of 155 signs, as identified in the Construction Documents.

Phase 2

Installation of the remaining signs not installed in Phase 1 due to conflicts with planned construction at the BPC Ballfields, and/or due to outstanding or unresolved approvals from City or State agencies.

- Installation of the remaining 5 signs
- Excluding the installation of Attic Stock



Scope of Work Overview

- Fabrication of 212 signs, 160 of which will be installed in the specified locations, as described in the Construction Documents.
- Provide all labor, materials, equipment and services necessary to fabricate and install the sign types, as described in the Construction Documents. Generate the graphic layouts and artwork for all individual signs.
- Be responsible for on-site project management.
- Provide a Maintenance Manual with instruction for proper care and maintenance of all fabricated and installed Signage, including any electrical systems and all other items specified in the Construction Documents.
